Such as acute inflammation during infection, internal and external trauma, surgery, stress response, brain death, tumor development and other conditions will occur quickly. IL-6 is involved in the occurrence and development of many diseases. Its blood levels are closely related to

inflammation, viral infections, and autoimmune diseases. Its changes are

earlier than CRP.
